Established in 1999 by the Russian entrepreneur Vladimir Potanin to help nurture active professionals and to develop strategic philanthropy in Russia, the Vladimir Potanin Foundation today is one of the largest private foundations in the country. The foundation's mission is to develop a philanthropy culture, uniting creative professionals who play a key role in solving current public issues and achieving sustainable social change; and to provide opportunities for new ideas and create a favourable environment to make them come true.
